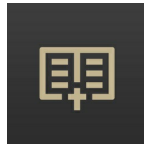
You Version Bible

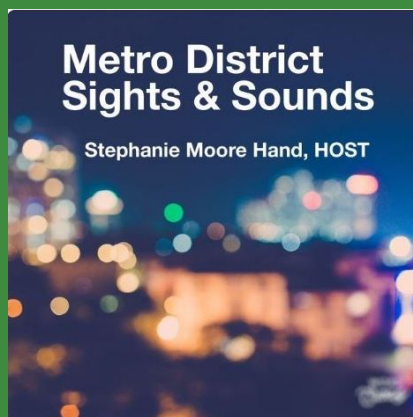
